Moderate cold wave conditions prevailed at isolated places over South Interior Karnataka.

Summary of observations recorded at 0830 hours IST:

Dry weather prevailed over the State.

Minimum temperatures rose at many places being appreciably so at a few places over Coastal Karnataka and changed little over Interior Karnataka. They were appreciably below normal at a few places over South Interior Karnataka; below normal at a few places over North Interior Karnataka and normal over Coastal Karnataka.

Chamarajanagar recorded lowest minimum temperature of **11.9** deg. Celsius in the plains of the State.

Forecast valid until the morning of 24th February 2012:

Mainly dry weather would prevail over the State.

Farmers Weather Bulletin for Karnataka: Forecast valid until the morning of 24th February 2012:

Mainly dry weather would prevail over all the districts of Coastal Karnataka, North Interior Karnataka and South Interior Karnataka.

Outlook for subsequent two days: No significant change is expected over the State.

Local Forecast for Bengaluru city & neighbourhood valid until the morning of 24th February 2012:

Partly cloudy sky. Fog/mist would occur in some areas during morning hours. Minimum temperature would be around 17 deg Celsius.
